VOTER INFORMATION

Eligibility: To be eligible to vote you must be a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age by Election Day, and a legal resident of Washington State. If you have been convicted of a felony, your right to vote is restored as long as you are not under the authority of the Department of Corrections. Once your right is restored you must re-register in order to receive a ballot.

How to register: You can register to vote online with VoteWA.gov or by filling out a paper form. You may also register when you get your new state driver license or ID at the Department of Licensing. New enhanced driver licenses are automatically registered to vote.

<i>Special Election</i>	February 13, 2024
<i>Presidential Primary</i>	March 12, 2024
<i>Special Election</i>	April 23, 2024
<i>Primary Election</i>	August 6, 2024
<i>General Election</i>	November 5, 2024

Vote by mail: Before each election, a ballot packet is mailed to every eligible registered voter. After voting and signing the return envelope, the voter can return it to an official ballot drop box (due by 8:00 pm election day) OR in the mail (postmarked by election day).
